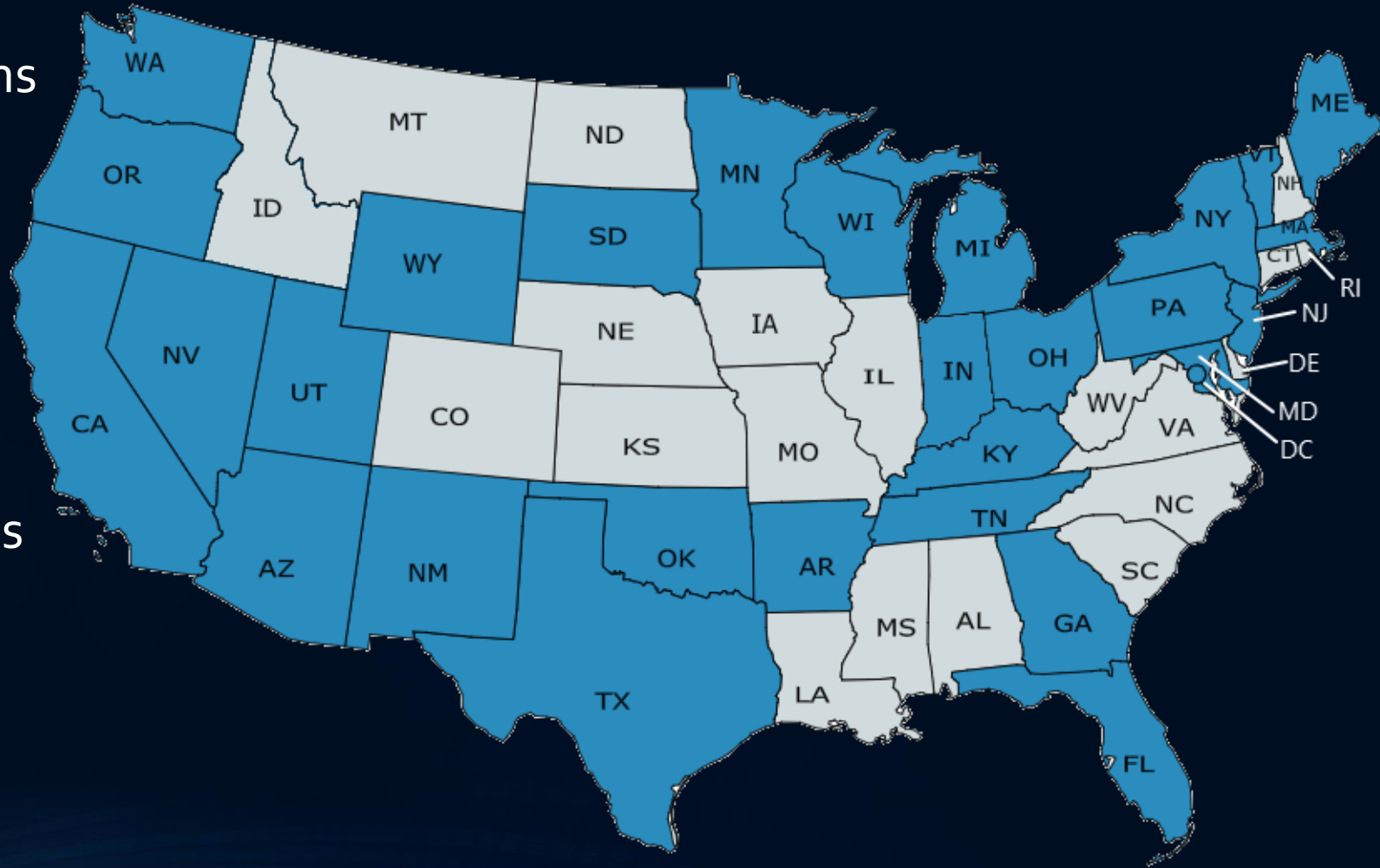

# Keys to a Successful Grants Management System

- Vendor History
- Platform Ability
- Flexibility

# Vendor History

- How much experience do they have with grants management?
- Do they have experience in the Justice sector, or do they offer a niche product that can't be adapted to your needs?
- Is grants management their primary focus, or is this one small product line in a very large portfolio?
- What experience do agencies like yours have with the vendor?

# Platform Ability

- Can the system process both competitive and formula grants?
- Can the system process grants with multiple funding sources?
- Can grant applicants send me everything I need in relation to this grant within the system?
- Can my staff review all of an applicant's materials in-system?
- Can the system handle award letters? Contracts? Payment vouchers?
- Can the system integrate with my accounting solution?



## Platform Ability (continued)

- Does the system have a way for me to track equipment or other assets?
- Can the vendor migrate my existing grant data into the new platform?
- Can I build reports on my own?
- Can I edit my form templates on my own?
- Can the system send notifications to users about their grant?

# Flexibility

- Do I want the new system to be branded to my agency's logos and colorways?
- Do I want the system to be configured to match my existing forms and processes?
- Do I want to be able to have a staff member edit and configure the forms and documents in the system?
- Do I want a staff member to be able to build reports in the system?
- Do I want the system to be able to handle additional processes outside of the traditional grants management steps?
